Adolescent Supply Wish List – Grades 7 & 8

All students are responsible for bringing to school **on September __1st__** these items that will be used by the Adolescent community collectively:

- 3 boxes of tissue
- 1 bottle of liquid hand soap or hand sanitizer
- 1 sponge or hand towel
- 1 pack of magic markers (**NOT permanent please**)
- 2 packs of dry erase markers
- 1 pack of crayons
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 bottle of Elmers glue (no glue sticks)
- 1 scissors

Each student **MUST** purchase these items for themselves:

- 4 packs of lined paper (wide lined)
- A box of number 2 pencils
- 2 Erasers
- 3 Ring Binder which can be used for all 6 subjects
- 6 folders
- 4 notebooks
- 2 highlighters

* Students should be comfortable with whatever they purchase as this is devised to assist them with their organization. If students prefer the zip-up type of binder or another style, that is fine.

A \$25.00 Additional fee is requested for every student. This will cover:

- The homework assignment notebook that will be given to the student on the first day of school
- Bus tickets for community service going outs
- Additional classroom supplies as needed for specific projects

In addition, field trips, and other events must be paid for independently of this initial \$25.00 fee.

There is an adolescent student store that the students run two days a week throughout the school year. As students run out of school supplies, they can purchase them from the store.
