Lily likes volley ball and enjoys playing the other teams. She likes to spend her free time painting.

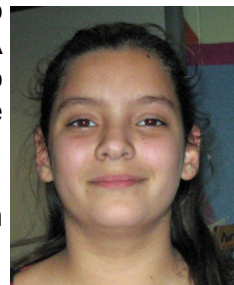

she doesn't like to see them get hurt.



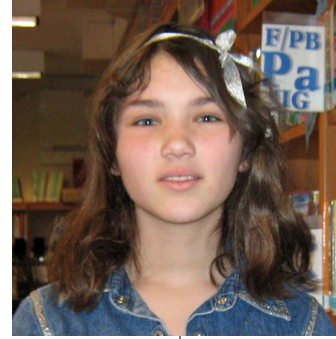
FORMER FAIRVIEW STUDENT BY NATHAN

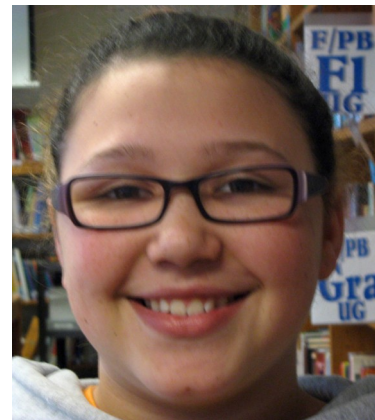
