- Kleenex

- Baby wipes
- Appropriate snack to be donated at various times of the school year, such as crackers, pretzels, graham crackers, cookies, fruit, goldfish, juice boxes, etc.

## K5

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 fat pencil
- 1 box of 8 fat crayons
- 1 glue stick
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- 1 folder

## Grade 1

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 box of 24 count crayons
- 5 pencils
- 1 pencil box
- 1 glue stick

## Grade 2

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 box of #2 pencils
- 2 soft pink erasers
- 1 folder for homework

## Grade 3

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 pencil case or pouch
- 2 boxes of #2 pencils
- 4 pens (2 red, 2 blue)
- 3 large soft pink erasers
- 1 glue stick
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 standard box of colored pencils
- 3 highlighters (1 green, 1 pink, 1 yellow)
- 4 one-inch binders
- 5 two-pocket folders
- 5 wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- 2 packs, 150 count, wide-ruled loose leaf paper
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex
- 2 rolls of paper towels

### Grade 5

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 3 boxes of #2 pencils
- 3 pens (1 red, 1 blue, 1 black)
- 3 large soft pink erasers
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 standard box of colored pencils
- 6 two-pocket folders
- 3-5 wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- 2 packs, 150 count, wide-ruled loose leaf paper
- 1 box of baby wipes

### Middle School (Grades 6-8)

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 box of 24 count #2 pencils
- 1 package of blue or black pens
- 3 two-pocket folders for each class
- 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks for each class
- 2 packs, 150 count, wide-ruled loose leaf paper for each class
- 1 three-inch binder
- 1 flash drive (optional)
- 1 standard calculator (optional)

### READ 180

- 1 pack, 150 count, wide-ruled loose leaf paper
- 1 flexible pencil case (not a box)
- 1 box of 24 count #2 pencils
- 1 package of blue or black pens
- 2 highlighters
- 2 binders (one for each semester)
- 1 box of Kleenex
