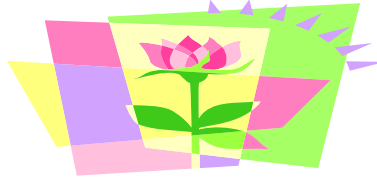




**Humboldt Park K-8 School's

**Spring Registration and Costs:**

1) **CLC Classes** cost \$10.00 for per Student Registration.

Class time is 2:45pm – 4:30pm.

2) **CLC Camp** cost \$6.00 per student, per day – AFTER 4:30pm.

Camp time is 4:30pm – 6:00pm.

\*All fees must be paid on a daily or weekly basis otherwise students will be dropped from the program – no exceptions.

\*All students **MUST** be picked up by 6:00pm or they will not be allowed to stay after school.

Scrabble, Chess, Jenga, Cranium – just to name a few. Challenge your friends while having fun!

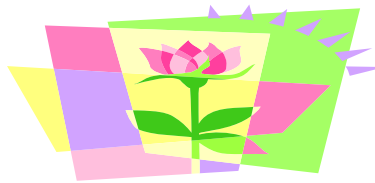
## GRADES 6<sup>TH</sup> – 8<sup>TH</sup>:
