Milwaukee Non-public School Title I Suggestion, Question and Complaint Resolution Process

Milwaukee Public Schools offers Title I educational services through third party providers or MPS teachers to eligible students in over 100 Milwaukee non-public schools. Participating non-public schools currently select one of four service providers: Catapult Learning, Learn It, Learning Exchange or Nonpublic Educational Services, Inc. (NESI).

MPS and the contracted service providers seek the input of non-public school communities in the development and ongoing improvement of their programs. To that end, we have developed a process to allow non-public school community members (staff members, families, supporters and even students) to communicate with us about our programs. We look forward to working with you to make our programs the best they can be for the students that we serve.

Informal and ongoing interactions: MPS communicates with participating non-public schools through:

- ❖ an e-mail listserv. The Milwaukee non-public school ESEA/IDEA listserv may be joined by sending an e-mail to requests@lists.milwaukee.k12.wi.us. In the body of your email indicate that you want to join the non-public listserv and provide the email addresses for yourself and any other individuals who want to join. When you request membership for more than one email account, separate each address by hitting the “enter” key between addresses.
- ❖ regular “consultation” meetings, training opportunities and seminars (a calendar of events can be found at the web site noted above), and through
- ❖ ongoing interactions between school communities and Title I staff.

We encourage you to learn about, support and participate in Title program activities in your school. We hope that many of your questions and issues can be addressed satisfactorily at the local school level. We are offering this process to address issues that might more suitably be dealt with by Title I service providers or Milwaukee Public Schools Title I staff.

You may use the Microsoft Word document for electronic submission via e-mail or a printed version of it or your own format for addressing the items contained in this form to pass along your suggestions, questions or complaints. You may request this form from any service provider or participating non-public school. It can be downloaded at the web site noted above.
