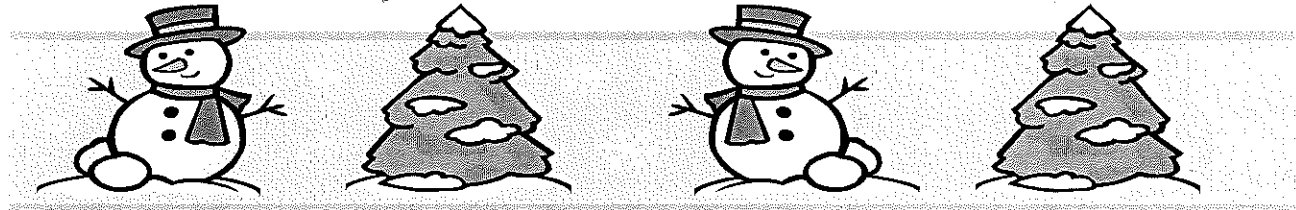

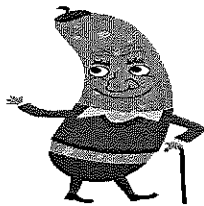

## DID YOU KNOW?

- ❖ You can call in your child's absences 24 hours a day at 414-304-6800, if you call after hours please leave a message
- ❖ You have 48 hours upon your child's return to school to submit an excuse
- ❖ Excuses can be submitted in either writing or electronic format for each absence. Different ways to submit an excuse electronically are: voicemail, email, or fax
- ❖ You can excuse your child up to 10 days by **WRITTEN** notice **PRIOR** to his/her absence for any reason, i.e. family reunion out of town, family vacation, moving
- ❖ Legally Excused Absences include:
  - Personal Illness
  - Funerals
  - Required Legal Appearances
  - Designated Religious Holidays
  - Medical or Dental Appointments
  - Family Emergencies- student absences which contribute to the health, safety, or financial well-being of the family
  - Driver's examinations
  - Educationally beneficial activities approved by the school principal
  - District sponsored activities, approved by the school principal
  - School suspensions up to 15 days, only during the expulsion process
- ❖ After your child is unexcused for 5 or more days in a semester, he/she is legally considered a habitual truant by Department of Public Instruction (DPI) standards and you will receive a certified truancy letter in the mail requesting a meeting with the principal and/or attendance designee of the school. At WCLL the attendance designee is the School Social Worker
- ❖ After the 8<sup>th</sup> unexcused absence a referral is automatically generated to the school social worker to follow up with that student and parent/guardian
- ❖ A school **must** generate a Truancy Abatement Burglary Suppression Program (TABS) referral when a student reaches the 25 unexcused absences however a TABS referral can be generated once a student reaches 5 unexcused absences
- ❖ A school reserves the right to submit a DA referral on your child if he/she meets the habitually truant DPI standards
- ❖ The principal and attendance designee reserve the right to request written documentation from a doctor or other professional provider for absences when the absenteeism is of a chronic nature

## Winter Health Update

Winter is here! The snow is beautiful, but the weather has gotten quite cold.



To help protect your child from frostbite and hypothermia, please be sure your child is wearing the following clothing before he/she leaves for school:

- ✓ Gloves or mittens.
- ✓ Earmuffs, hat or scarf that covers the ears. Students with asthma can also cover their mouth and nose with the scarf if the temperature is very cold.
- ✓ Warm boots or shoes big enough to allow a second pair of socks.
- ✓ Socks that are long enough to at least cover the ankles.
- ✓ Long-sleeved clothing under their coat.

When temperatures are very cold, tights, leggings or “long johns” under trousers or skirts are also helpful.

If you suspect frostbite, check skin for whiteness or blistering. If the skin is white, or blistered, **DO NOT RUB IT**. Instead place the affected area next to a warm body part, such as the armpit, abdomen, fold of elbow or knee, or place in lukewarm water. This will allow gentle thawing without causing further damage. Frostbite requires medical attention.
